

Project Title: Request for Proposals for Dawson City Wastewater Treatment Plant

Attention All Planholders:

General

- 1.1. This addendum shall be read in conjunction with the specifications.
- 1.2. Where inconsistent with the above, this addendum shall govern. This addendum forms an integral part of the Contract Documents and shall be included therein.
- 1.3. No consideration shall be allowed for increases (extras) to the CONTRACT PRICE due to failure of the Contractor being familiar with this addendum.
- 1.4. It is the planholder's responsibility to ensure all addenda have been received prior to the closing time and date.
- 1.5. The planholder should acknowledge receipt of addenda on the tender form.

Scope of this addendum:

1. On the addendum form, clause 1.5 states "The planholder should acknowledge the receipt of addenda on the tender form." Instead of using the tender form to acknowledge receipt of addenda, the following change is made to the RFP:

In Part 4 Proposal Format and Content, in Section 4.3 Technical Proposal and Mandatory Elements, under Covering Letter on page 71, add the following sentence to the end of the single paragraph:

"Provide the following statement in the covering letter:

I/We acknowledge receipt of the following addenda issued during this Request for Proposal: # _____ # _____ # _____

2. Replace the 5.2.3 Relative Annual Operating Cost Estimates formula (page 89) with the following:

Price - Lowest X Available Points
Price - Proponent

3. Replace the 5.3 Financial Proposals formula (page 91) with the following:

Price - Lowest X Available Points
Price - Proponent

4. In Section 5.2.4 Long Term Maintenance (page 90), add the following text and formula:

"Long Term Maintenance Costs will be evaluated based on the information provided in the proposal. The Owner reserves the right to adjust the submitted costs based on an independent assessment of the costs provided. These adjusted costs will then be used in the final ranking process. The basis of the scoring for the long term maintenance costs is as follows:

Price - Lowest X Available Points
Price - Proponent


Lowest Price receives full available points."
