### **Ground-breaking Ceremony for Dawson Wastewater Treatment Plant**

DAWSON -The City of Dawson and Yukon government announced today that a contract has been signed with Vancouver-based Corix Water Systems for the design and construction of a wastewater treatment plant for Dawson. A ground-breaking ceremony will take place in Dawson City, at the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Turner Street, July 7 at 11 a.m.

"We are very pleased to announce this significant project milestone," Archie Lang, Minister of Highways and Public Works said. "The project is just one example of the Yukon Government's commitment to investing in communities and infrastructure."

"On behalf of my constituents, I am particularly happy to see this project making real progress towards solving a long-standing issue for this community," said Steve Nordick, MLA for the Klondike Region. "Many hours of careful research and collaboration have gone into selecting a technology that will meet Dawson's needs for a long-term, sustainable, and affordable solution."

"I am confident we have found a contractor and a design that can meet the city's needs," said John Steins, mayor of Dawson City. "We are pleased to see Corix Water Systems join the project team and expect our strong partnership with Yukon government will continue through the final design, construction and commissioning stages."

"On behalf of our project partners we would like to express how thrilled we are to join the Dawson Wastewater project team," said Jack Touhey, Vice-president and Chief Operating Officer of Corix Water Systems. "With over 65 years in the business, we understand the importance of such key infrastructure to communities of all sizes. Representatives from the City of Dawson, Yukon government and Corix Water Systems will be present at the ceremony. Discussions between the three parties will now begin to finalize the design of the plant and proceed with an environmental assessment.
